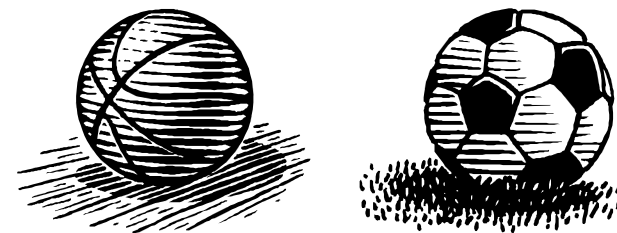

## About CRUSADER CAMP

Crusader Camp was started by former TBS Head Coach Aaron Spuler for boys and girls to strengthen their basketball skills along with developing the attitude and character it takes to win in games and in life. Demand was so great that we added a week for soccer. Our camp is staffed with high school head coaches, assistant coaches and current/former players, and we have a high staff to camper ratio so everyone gets personal attention.

## Monday-Friday DAILY SCHEDULE

Our typical day involves many drills, technique stations, a lunch break and games (see sample schedule below). All campers are assigned to "teams," each with a leader and assistant leader. Campers practice and go to sessions with their teams for all five days—it's a great way to make friends and get to know others!

3:00—3:15 p.m. .... Pick Up

**DROP OFF & PICK UP:** Please drop off your child by 8:30 am. Pick up begins at 3:00 pm. All campers must be picked up by 3:15 pm.

On the last day of Basketball Camp, July 27, join us for our Crusader Camp Family Time, at a free family barbecue. We will have a special presentation for parents. Please join us as your camper shares what they learned this week; we'll also present awards.
